### History & Mission

Kent State University (KSU) Geauga Campus was established in 1964 to provide local access to higher education to Geauga County and neighboring regions of Northeast Ohio. The Campus offers several four-year degrees as well as two-year technical degrees. The Burton location, conveniently located in the center of Geauga County, is situated on 87 beautiful acres just 35 minutes from the Eastern Cleveland suburbs. In 1991, Kent State Geauga expanded to include the Twinsburg Academic Center which is now located in the "Old School" near the corner of Darrow Road (Rt. 91) and East Aurora Road (Rt. 82).

### The Kent State Advantage

Kent State Geauga students have access to resources of all eight campuses. Resources include the Kent Campus Library and Career Services Center. The campuses share many common curricula: thus in most cases, students may begin a program at any campus and relocate to another. Students may also attend classes at more than one campus at a time. Students will find small class sizes at both Kent State Geauga locations.

### Applying to Kent State Geauga (open admissions policy)

1. Complete either the online application at [www.geauga.kent.edu](http://www.geauga.kent.edu) or paper application.
2. Submit a non-refundable \$30.00 application fee along with the application.
3. Send official high school transcript stating date of graduation, or official GED certificate, or documentation of completed home schooling program. \*\*\*If transferring from another higher education institution, also send official college transcripts.

Note: For both locations, **submit all application materials to the Geauga Campus.** Kent Campus applicants need not reapply.

### Resources

*Academic Support Services-* offers tutoring and accommodates students with disabilities.

*Career Resources-* the Self Directed Search tool is free for students and a career exploration course is offered.

*Computer Resources-* 5 computer labs, 3 smart classrooms and additional computers are available on campus.
